- 5. The Documentation Center of Cambodia will pay your transportation expenses and organize accommodation and food for three days (24-26, Dec. 2010).

## **GUIDELINE FOR WRITING**

- 1. Describe the village history; it can be a real story or a legend related to the village where you are teaching.
- 2. Describe the socio-economic situation in the village during the Sangkum Reas Niyum.
- 3. Describe the history of the village during the Khmer Rouge regime:
  - Where were base people evacuated to? Where did new people come from?
  - How were people killed?
  - How many mass graves are in the village? Where are the mass graves?
  - What is the number of deaths in the village during the Khmer Rouge based on your estimation?
  - Describe types of work conducted, leaders in the village (name and sex) and the region and zone in which the village was administered.
- 4. Describe reconstruction efforts of the village after the Khmer Rouge regime (since 1979), which should include the following points:
  - The reopening of the school where you are teaching.
  - A brief history of the school related to the village.
- 5. If you have information in addition to the above points, please include it.
